**AP classes in the 12<sup>th</sup> grade:** Please note AP classes taken in the 12<sup>th</sup> grade are not applied towards the AA. So although the classes may be listed, if they were completed in the 12<sup>th</sup> grade they can't be applied towards your degree.

**Core courses as general electives:** Once a core area has been satisfied for graduation then any additional credits in that area will be applied to your general elective requirements. For example, you only need 3 credits of Humanities, so if you pass both AP Art History and AP Music Theory 3 credits will be applied to your Humanities requirement and the other 3 credits will be applied towards your GE requirement. Another example, if you complete College Algebra and Liberal Arts math but later pass AP Calculus your AP Calculus credits will be applied towards your general electives.
